



Depositing snow on public streets, roads, and alleys is against the law and is punishable as a misdemeanor. Maximum sentence is \$700.00, 90 days in jail, or both. This is in accordance with City of Hibbing Ordinance Section 7.04, Subdivision 6, and Minnesota Statute 160.27. Pushing, blowing, or shoveling snow onto public driving surfaces hinders snow removal efforts and many times is done after streets are already plowed, causing narrow traffic lanes or frozen ruts. Such action may also subject a person to civil liability in the event of a traffic accident caused by snow and ice placed on the roadway. This **civil liability** can extend to **both** the **property owner** and the **person who actually placed** the snow on to the roadway. The City of Hibbing is responsible for plowing and maintaining approximately 270 miles of streets, roads, and alleys.

Your assistance and cooperation in keeping these many miles in clear and safe winter driving condition will be very much appreciated.
