**SCOPE OF POSITION:**

General Statement of Duties: To operate truck with equipment to perform high pressure sewer cleaning of sewers, vacuum pickup of debris, etc. , from manholes, wet wells, grit chambers, digesters, pump stations, catch basins, streets and curbs, and to perform street flushing and spraying.

Work Environment: Outdoors all-weather conditions, confined space, smelly, wet, dirty, noisy condition.

Supervision Received: Cemetery Sexton/Sanitary & Sewer Foreman

Supervision Exercised: General Laborer, Skilled Laborer

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The following list is not intended to be all inclusive, as duties will vary depending upon the direction of the Cemetery Sexton/Sanitary & Sewer Foreman

- Receive instructions from supervision.
- Check oil pressure, amperage, air pressure, temperature gauges, etc. Check fuel, boom, and operate switches.
- Clean sewer lines by forcing water under pressure into upstream manholes. Regulate speed etc., pump into tanks.
- Use jet-vac to remove deposits in manholes.
- Empty tank as required.
- Clean culverts or blocked lines with hose and pressure pump. Dispose of material.
- Remove roots, encrusted low grade cement, and asphalt deposits with root cutter and pressure hoses.
- Clean refuse receptacles, catch basins, and construction machines with kerosene, detergents, and water as required.
- Remove sludge or debris from tank as required and return excess liquids from truck to cleaning area.
- May flush streets, etc., as required.
- Keep working areas in clean and orderly condition.
- Check manholes and catch basins, clean and repair as needed.
- Assist operator in sewer line and manhole repairs.

**Secondary Assignments**

- Drive and operate all trucks as directed.



**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:**

- Perform work of a semi-repetitive nature where judgment is required to obtain results.
- Reason through problems involving set up and operation of moderately complex equipment. Use considerable judgment.
- Manipulate controls of complex machine at rapid pace involving high degree of coordination.
- Use high degree of care and attention. Prevent damage to equipment where responsibility is placed on operator and not entirely on automatic devices.
- Close mental and visual application for controlling machine at rapid pace requiring close coordination.
- Moderate physical exertion. Climb and work from ladders. Handle medium weight materials up to 55 lbs.
- Ability to work in confined space.
- Ability to pass City's respiratory face-fit test.
- Ability to understand and follow City confined space permit policy.
- Attend training and education seminars.
- Must maintain daily log of work performance.
- Maintain valid Class "B" CDL with Tanker Endorsement.


**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High School diploma, or equivalent
- Class "B" Driver's License with Tanker Endorsement
- Must pass City's respiratory face-fit test.
- Subject to random drug & alcohol testing.
- Must pass annual pulmonary fitness test.
- Ability to lift up to 55 pounds.
